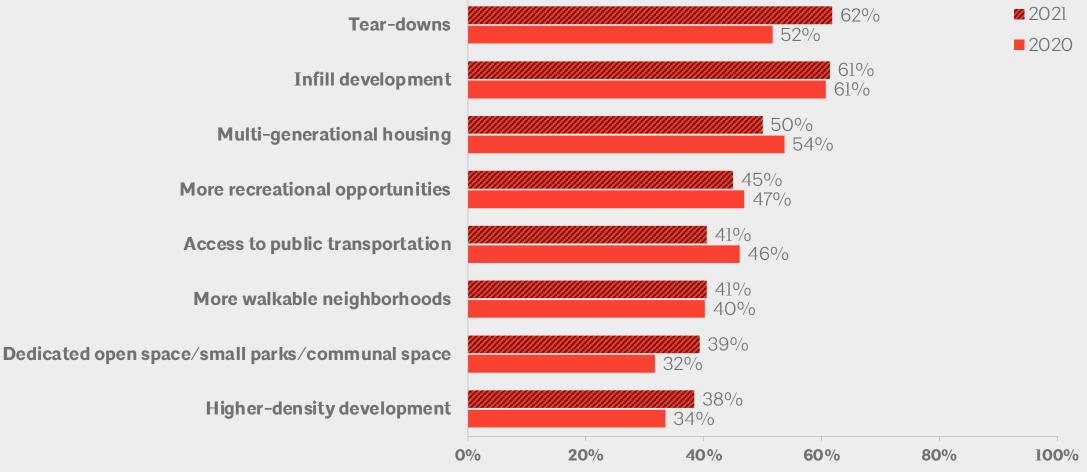
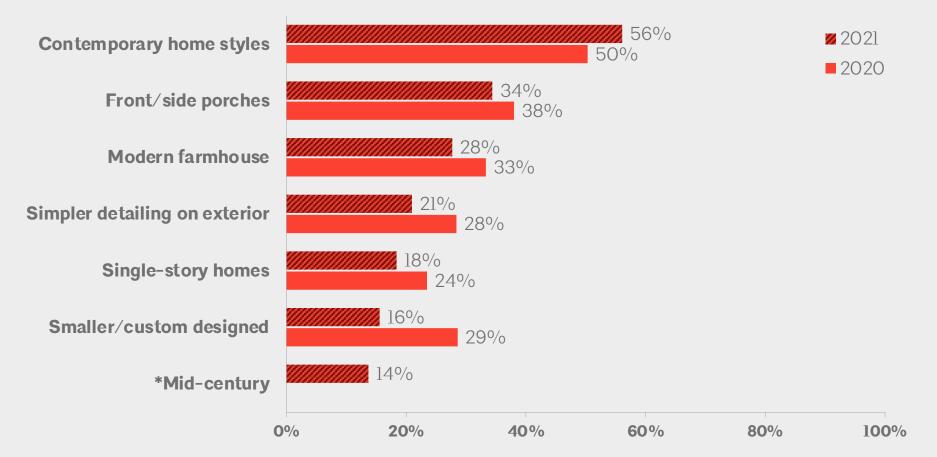
# **FIGURE 1** Tear-downs in desirable locations saw an increase this year as well as dedicated open spaces in developments

### **FIGURE 2** Contemporary home styles grew in popularity and continue to top the list of home styles

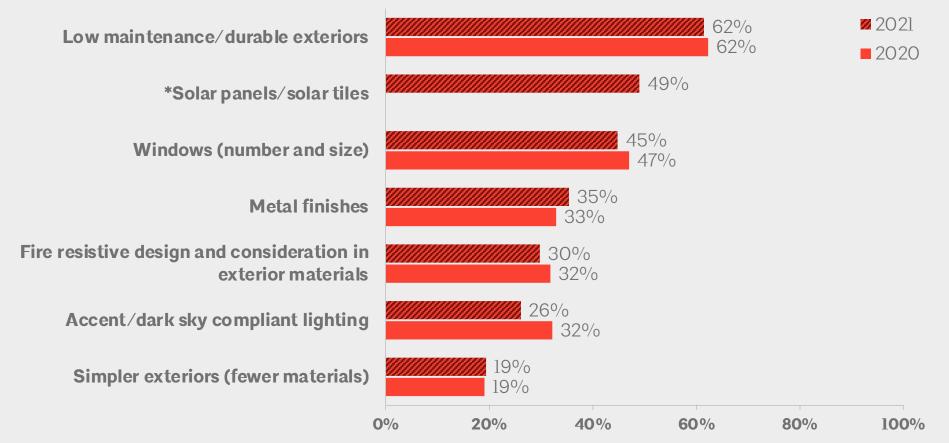
% of respondents reporting popularity of home style "increasing" minus % reporting "decreasing;" data from Q3 2021 compared to data from Q3 2020

# **FIGURE 3** Durability/low maintenance remains a popular choice for home exteriors along with solar panels/solar tiles

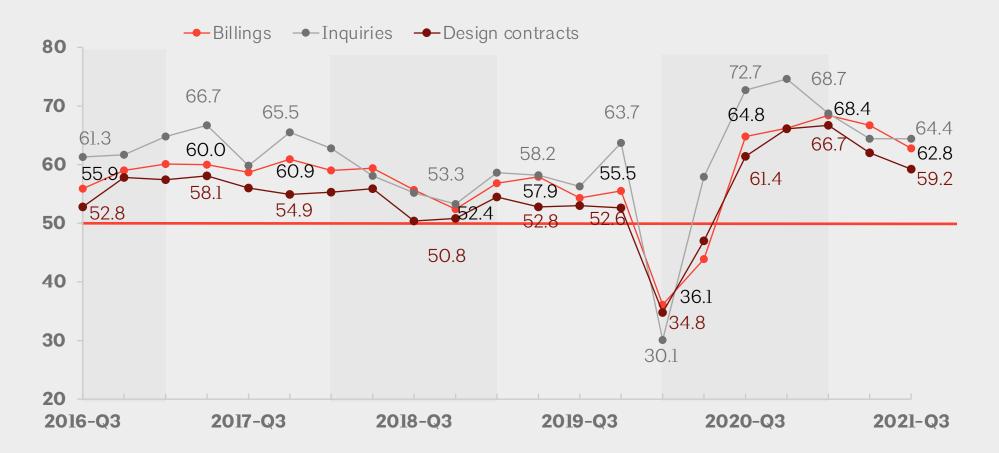

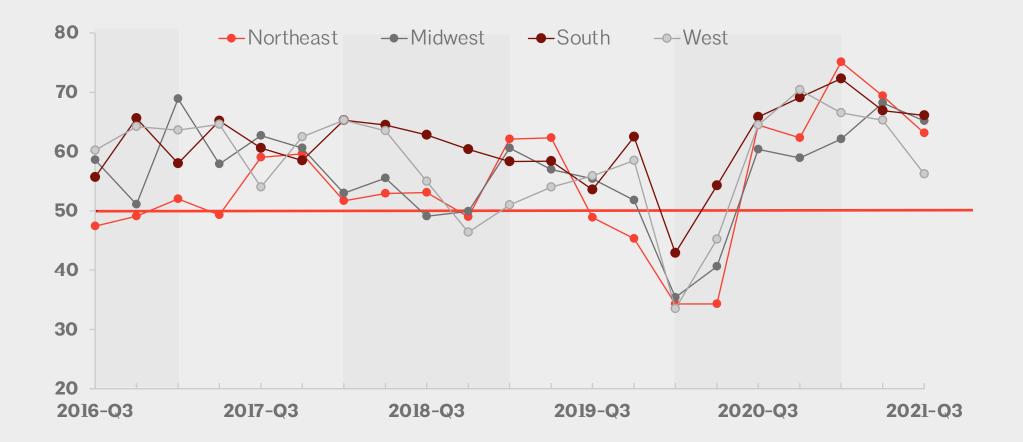
#### **FIGURE 4 Project billings, inquiries, and design contracts remain strong in Q3**

Diffusion index: 50 = no change from previous quarter; data are seasonally adjusted; data from Q3 2016-Q3 2021



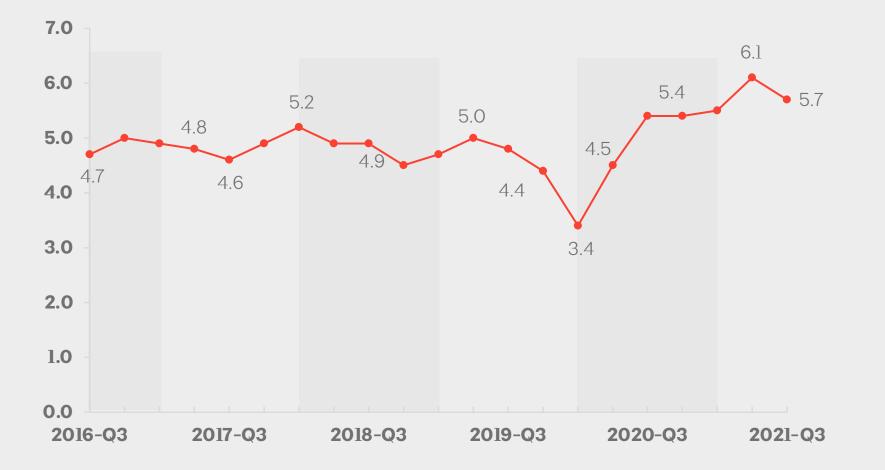
#### **FIGURE 5** Firms in all regions report strong growth in Q3
